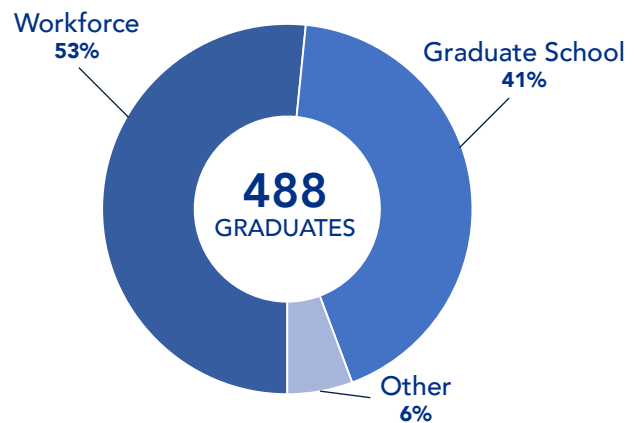

2018-19 Graduate Outcomes



Our 2018-19 outcomes are collected from surveys completed by Summer '18, Fall '18, and Spring '19 graduates. A total of 488 students responded to our survey out of 489 graduates, a response rate of 99.8%. The surveys were last collected in May 2019.

Application and Review Process

The application for admission includes:

- Three required essays
- Short-answer questions about leadership experiences, academic honors, etc.,
- Online recommendations from two to four recommenders
- The student high-school academic record. (We utilize the academic record the student submits as part of their Penn State application. No other documentation is required.)

It has long been the practice of Schreyer Honors College not to consider standardized test scores as they are not accurate predictors of a student's success in the Schreyer Honors College.

The selection committee, made up of faculty and staff, will review short-answer responses, essays and letters of recommendation. Each application is assigned to two readers.

College staff will review the academic record assessing how broadly applicants have challenged themselves within the context of their school. If a student participated in the optional interview process we may consider this information in our final decision.

Each reviewer will rank the applicant and those rankings will be used, collectively, to make our final selections.

Applicants may choose to participate in our optional Admissions Alumni Interview Program (AAIP) if they apply by November 1, 2019.

* **Please note that the Schreyer Honors College does not have an application fee.** The Penn State application fee is \$60. It can be waived with a request from a guidance counselor. Penn State operates on a modified rolling admission basis with admission getting progressively more competitive after November 30. National College Decision Day is May 1, 2020.
